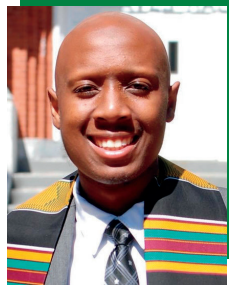

## Our Wins & Milestones

I had my first in person undergraduate research opportunity at Harvard Medical School in their Summer Honors Undergraduate Research Program (SHURP). I did research in genetics for the whole summer. When I arrived back at Hampton, I applied to 9 grad schools by November. I was also named Student of the Month in the School of Science for November of 2022 and was nominated by Hampton University to become a Rhodes Scholar. Though I did not become a Rhodes Scholar, I was honored that the school would even consider me. As the semester came to a close, I began to receive invitations to interview with many of the graduate programs I had applied to. The interview process took hours, days, and weeks from the end of January through March. I was accepted into the Biological Sciences program at UIC, the Human Genetics program and the Vivien Thomas Scholars Initiative at Johns Hopkins, and the Genetics and Genomics program at Stanford University.

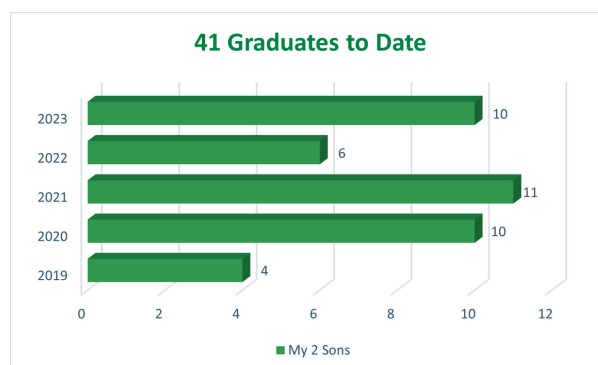
## A Word From Our 2015 My 2 Sons Inaugural Scholarship Recipient

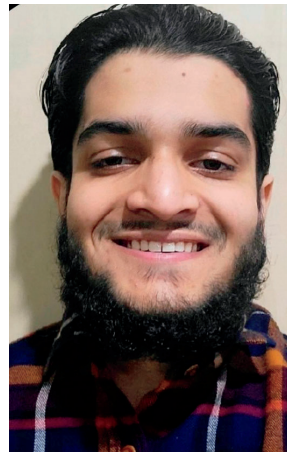

In October of 1989 my oldest son, Sean Cater, was murdered at age 21. As a result of this tragedy I founded Giving God the Glory Ministries in 1997. Under this not-for-profit Ministry, I facilitate and organize bereavement programs and support groups as well as mentoring programs for teens and women. My youngest son, John Cater Jr., an Award Winning Journalist, died in January of 2010 at age 32. This was 6 months after he won the prestigious Emmy Award for Excellence in Reporting.
